## W&O unit to relocate from Florida as part of facility expansion

The nation's largest supplier of pipes, valves and fittings is expanding its Houston facility, adding about 20 new jobs and further boosting Houston's manufacturing industry.

W&O Supply Inc.'s facility in East Houston will house three company divisions under one roof, the first for the Jacksonville, Fla.-based company.

"Putting several W&O divisions in one location facilitates W&O's focus of providing complete solutions for its customers," says President and CEO Jack Guidry.

The company's 100,000-square-foot facility at 8000 Market St. is an expansion of the existing Houston facility, but two divisions -- the SPACE and engineered products and automation, or EP/A, divisions -- will relocate to join the oil and gas division and a marine products sales division.
